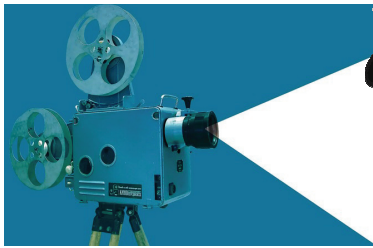

That says you are never too old to learn something new.

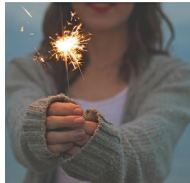
How do you see your role as a good leader?

★ Harmonizing

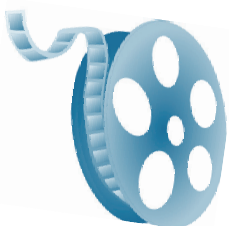
