Roles and Responsibilities:

I. Transformational Leader

- Will be responsible to lead at least one church through a transformational process each calendar year

II. Resource to Associations

- Work with Association Executive Committees to carry out the program of the Association:
 - Nominating Committees
 - Special Events
 - Annual Meetings
 - Cooperative Ministries

III. Resource Churches:

- Pastoral and Staff Search Committees
- Conflict Resolution
- Mission Involvement and Support
- Pulpit Supply
- Coaching
- Church Development and Health

IV. Team Responsibilities

- Own and articulate the vision of the WVBC to constituent churches
- Participate with other members of the staff in developing and implementing programming which will fulfill the mission of the *Convention*
