AREA MINISTRY

One facet of the West Virginia Baptist Convention's ministry that is supported by the Mountain State Mission Offering is Area Ministry. Though other West Virginia Baptist Convention staff members are regularly in our churches, Area Ministers unique ministry has them in churches virtually weekly.



Has your Area Minister engaged your church lately? If not, he likely soon will. Area Ministers often fill the pulpits at churches in their areas. They preach for pastors who are away on vacation or continuing education events, preach special occasions like ordinations, and pastor installations and they are often asked to preach revivals. Sometimes they visit area churches simply to offer encouragement to the pastor and people.

Some call the Area Minister a "pastor to pastors." Certainly the AMs are available to counsel, coach and resource local pastors. In addition, they fill pastoral roles when the pastor and/or his family are in crisis.

One major function of Area Ministers is to work with pulpit committees when there is a vacancy in a church's pulpit. Much time is spent guiding those committees through the vital task of leading the church to the call of a new spiritual leader. In addition, the Area Minister is available to work with finance committees, trustees, deacons or other committees as invited.

Area Ministry is not limited to the local church, however. The associations of the West Virginia Baptist Convention also experience the work of the Area Minister. He is engaged in the executive committees helping to plan and pursue the association's ministry. Often the Area Minister leads, or is the point person for the association's ministers' group. In many cases, the Area Minister is called on to teach classes for the School of Christian Studies which helps to train pastors, teachers and other church leaders.

CAMP COWEN

Pray as the work continues on sound, video and lighting. This is another example of God providing people and resources to make the West Virginia Baptist Camp at Cowen a better place!
