The Women's Leadership Academy focuses on the basics of Christian leadership with an emphasis on Biblical insights for leadership, personal spiritual growth, servant leadership as modeled by Jesus, and God's vision for the future.

The Academy modules also covers the "How-to's" of organizing for effective ministry, communication within the ministry team and to the broader audience, shepherding and mentoring, selecting ministry activities and planning, resourcing for effective ministry and evaluation.

Women from age 18 and older are encouraged to participate in the 10-session Academy. Several modules will be taught each year, and participants can begin at any time during the two-year cycle.

EVALUATION
