Together, we built a camp that since 1943 has served as a place "where people meet Jesus and grow as disciples in a community of faith." It is in this community that nearly 2,000 youth come every summer and just last year alone, we saw 95 people place their faith in Christ.



Together, we established a college ministry that has been "changing lives that change the world" since 1967. Today, Baptist Campus Ministries reaches out to nearly 60,000 students on nine different campuses around the state. This summer, more than 30 of these students will serve as interns in our churches around the state or with our mission partners around the world.



Together, we support a Christian center, which has been ministering to children and the Weirton community for more than a century.




Together, we have done disaster relief, rebuilding homes and communities in Kanawha, Greenbrier, Nicholas, Marion, Webster, Wyoming, Logan and Mingo counties.



Together, we invest in pastors, providing scholarships and other opportunities for continuing education, providing support during times of need, working with pulpit committees, and helping churches become everything God wants them to be.



Together, we built a conference center that has been used to equip and train leaders for more than 50 years. It serves as the home for numerous conferences, camps and training events, and we have seen more than 700 people place their faith in Christ here over the last decade. It also serves as the home for Brothers' Keeper, an outreach ministry for Jackson Country, repairing more than 1,000 homes over the last 20 years.



Together, we have created the School of Christian Studies, a program where we have equipped more than 700 people for ministry, with more than 70 individuals currently serving as pastors within our family of churches.



Together, we disciple men and women, youth and children all around the state.



Together, since 2000, we have planted 18 new churches and helped revive several more.



Together, we partner in missions. Since our formation in 1865 we have commissioned 41 different full-time missionaries, including seven who are still on the field. Together, we have also commissioned thousands of short-term missionaries to Nicaragua, Honduras, Cuba, Haiti, the Dominican Republic, Mexico, Bolivia, South Africa, Lebanon, India, Thailand, Japan, the Philippines, Russia, Hungary and many other countries.
