Price Increase, 6% Sales Tax for 2020 and Municipality Tax

Price Increase

The West Virginia Baptist Convention Bobby Wood School of Christian Studies will be raising their prices \$2.00 per class in 2020.

Six Percent Sales Tax

State law now requires us to collect 6% sales tax on our inperson class fees. All registration forms will be updated to show the sales tax to add per class. In the fee section of your registration form, if it says "+ with a dollar amount," you must take the amount listed and add it to your fee. If you see the text "sales tax has been added to your fee" you will pay the fee as is and won't need to pay anything additional.

Municipality Sales/Use Tax

Beginning immediately, certain municipalities (Elkins, Fairmont, Harrisville, Parkersburg and Romney) where some of our six-week and one-day classes are held will require us to collect an additional 1% sales/use tax. All classes where this occurs will have an insert in the mailing to tell you how much to add to your total fee.

*ATTENTION:

If you are attending the Hospital Ministry (E-04) one-day class at the Elkins First Baptist Church location, please note: We are now required to collect an additional 1% tax (on top of the 6% state sales tax) on the class fee because Elkins has a sales/use tax.
