- 1.) Write a 2-3 page paper (double spaced, Times New Roman 12 point font) about a hospital visit* you make following the class on April 25. The paper is due by June 1, 2020. Please e-mail or mail your paper to the e-mail or mailing address listed in the pre-class assignment above.
- *Before making your visit, please contact your local hospital to make sure it is safe to do so. The due date may be adjusted depending on restrictions related to Covid-19. Please don't put yourself or anyone at risk.
- 2.) Please try to include the following in your paper: an outline of the visit, identified theological/religious themes and your pastoral interventions.
