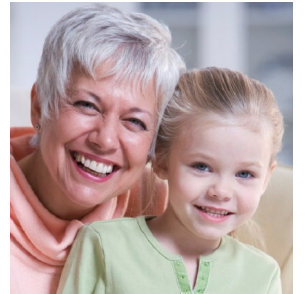
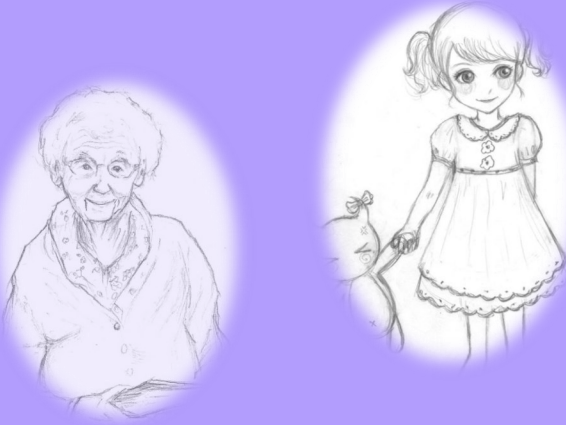

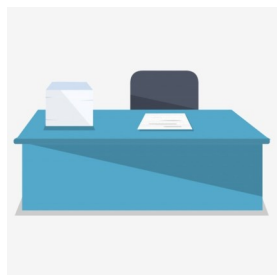

CHOOSE FORWARD IN 2021

We just said goodbye to 2020 - the year of the pandemic. It changed daily life; work, school, church, sports, family celebrations, weddings, hospitals, shopping, restaurants, time with friends ... the list is endless! For American Baptist Women's Ministries (ABWM), board meetings went virtual: no in-person state events, local groups of women rarely met together if at all, spring and fall rallies cancelled, the 2020 financial goals for ministries not met ... enough to be defeated! Darkness creeps in!

I read an awesome devotion dealing with darkness I can't quit thinking about. It is profound spiritual wisdom for all of us as we maneuver through this pandemic.

Devotion: *Plunging Into the Darkness*

Jerry Sittser tells of an experience shortly after he lost his wife, his mother, and his four-year-old daughter in a tragic accident. He says, "I dreamed of a setting sun. I was frantically running west, trying desperately to catch it and remain in its fiery warmth and light. But I was losing the race. The sun was beating me to the horizon and was soon gone. Exhausted, I stopped running and glanced with foreboding over my shoulder to the east. I saw a vast darkness closing in on me. I was terrified by that darkness. I wanted to keep running after the sun."

Sharing the dream with his sister, she pointed out that "the quickest way for anyone to reach the sun and the light of day is not to run west, chasing after the setting sun, but to head east, plunging into the darkness until one comes to the sunrise." That was the turning point - sometimes the only way into the light we long for is straight through the darkness. We go there, not alone, but in the keeping of the God the psalmist acclaims: "To you the night shines as bright as day. Darkness and light are the same to you." Psalm 139:12

The One-Year Devotion for Women

Yes ladies, we must CHOOSE FORWARD!

Face the darkness of this pandemic by running right through it toward the LIGHT of this world!

God knew the darkness we would face in 2020 on a personal level and as a soldier for Christ.

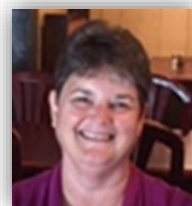
A MESSAGE FROM YOUR ABWM SECRETARY

WV Hope

WV Hope is a new ministry added to the ABWM agenda in 2019 as a way to help those in need in our local areas of West Virginia. There are lots of questions about it as well as some confusion, so here are some pointers to help you decide which route to take with your group/church, etc.:



- *WV Hope ministries are in place from January-December each calendar year.*
- *Ministries selected for 2021 are on our webpage at wvbc.org. (move your cursor to Ministries heading; when that menu opens move cursor to Auxiliaries; when that menu opens, CLICK on WV ABWM.) There you will find not only an information sheet listing their needs, but also a video.*
- *There are no quotas for these ministries. Give what you wish from the goodness of your heart.*
- *You are at liberty to select one or all of those four ministries or*
- *You can go to the International Ministries website. There you will find page after page of White Cross ministries to choose from or*
- *You can select a local ministry in your community to support. If you choose this option, be sure to list the name of the ministry on your year-end report.*
- *If you have a ministry in your area to be considered for the 2022 WV Hope, they must be received by the coordinator (Libby Young - mailing info below) by April 15th of each year.*
- *Just a reminder for those of you who participated in the 2020 WV Hope Ministries: your year-end report is due to your association officer by January 15th and association reports are due to me (contact information below) by January 31st.*

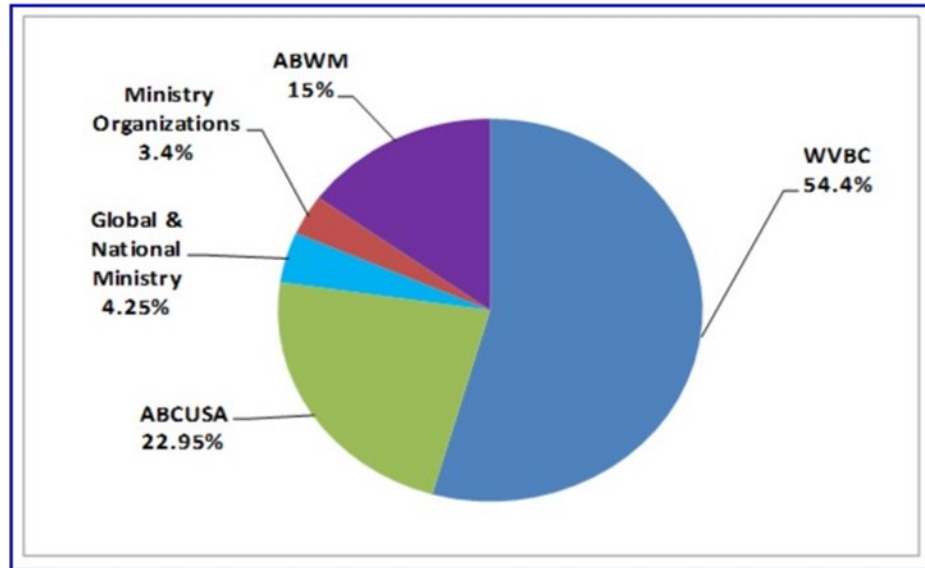

Love Gift 2021

Goal - \$100,000

(NOT JUST FOR WOMEN . . .)



In 1932, American Baptist Churches faced a \$500,000 deficit, and it was feared the financial crisis would limit God's work in the denomination. American Baptist Churches asked individuals to give financial contributions in excess of their tithes and pledges. Women specifically, were challenged to raise \$150,000 to help meet the crisis. Receiving the challenge, women began the over-and-above contribution called Love Gift. The Love Gift initiative, begun in 1932, outlived the Great Depression and continues today to bless the breadth of American Baptist ministry and mission happening in regions, the U.S. and around the world.

Camp Alpha is a church camp located in Ryazan, Russia, who hosted their first campers in 2017. The camp currently consists of two picnic shelters, two large metal storage containers repurposed into cabins and outhouses for restroom facilities. Tents provide additional housing for the campers. Meals must either be brought in from local churches or cooked onsite over an open campfire. Taking into account the rustic nature of the camp, it is amazing that 65 kids were in attendance in 2019! The WVBC partnership with the Russian churches has helped them to create the camp in resemblance to our very own Camp Cowen and Parchment Valley Conference Center.

The American Baptist Women's Ministries of West Virginia have adopted Camp Alpha for their Mission Outreach Project (MOP) 2020-2021 project. We hope our goal of \$6,000 will help make improvements to the camp that will encourage more children to come meet Jesus at Camp Alpha!
