Text for this course: Encountering the Old Testament: A Christian Survey - Third Edition

Course Requirements:

- -- Class attendance and participation. (No more than one absence without make-up.) -- Read pages 257-466 in the text. Old Testament I (B-01) covers the first half of
- the book.
- -- Choose one personality and write a paper giving the requirements listed below or read Job through Malachi in your Bible and turn in a paper saying you have done so.
- -- Payment of all fees.
- -- Complete any other assignments as given by the instructor.

The text we are using for this course lends itself to be broken down into four sections, following the heading of the book.

Old Testament II (B-02) will be centered on Part 3 and 4 and Old Testament I (B-01) will include Part 1 and Part 2.

Students are asked to choose two personalities - one for Old Testament II (B-02) (and one for Old Testament I (B-01)) and write a paper giving:

- 1.) The names of the personality
- 2.) A brief history of the personalities
- 3.) The major contribution these personalities made to Jewish history
- 4.) The reason these personalities were chosen
- 5.) How the personalities chosen impacted New Testament life

6.) How the personalities chosen have impacted on the student's life

The papers will be discussed during the concluding session of each course.
