Evangelism (Mod-6 - Six-Hour) One-Day Class

This class is required for the diploma in Pastoral Ministry, the certificate in Lay Ministry and the Teaching Certificate. This class may be chosen to fulfill one requirement for the certificate in General Studies' Ministries.

ASSIGNMENT: Be prepared to work in small groups and perform in role play to:

- 1.) Discuss effective and ineffective (past and present) methods of evangelism,
- 2.) Present common objections (by Christians) to "do the work of an evangelist,"
- 3.) Present common objectives used by yet-to-be Christians when they're evangelized,
- 4.) "How to" address the objection results of presentations discovered in items two and three,
- 5.) Compare sales techniques which produce results that may be applicable to evangelism,
- 6.) Define the basic components of presenting the gospel supported by scripture,
- 7.) Explain how to evangelize the "lepers" and/or the "elitists" of today's culture.
