



Directions to Parchment Valley:

From Charleston: Take I-77 north to Exit 138, bearing into the left turn lane on the exit ramp. At the traffic light, turn left onto State Route 62 south for approximately 0.6 mile (landmarks are the American Electric Power facility on the left and a veterinary clinic on the right.) At the first intersection, the WV State Police office will be on the right and Parchment Valley Road (big, blue sign) will be on the left. Turn onto Parchment Valley Road and travel for 2 miles. The road will open to the Parchment Valley Conference Center complex.

From Parkersburg: Take I-77 south to Exit 138, bearing into the left turn lane on the right turn lane. At the traffic light, bearing into the right turn lane. At the traffic light, turn right onto State Route 62 south for approximately 0.6 mile (landmarks are the American Electric Power facility on the left and a veterinary clinic on the right.) At the first intersection, the Road (big, blue sign) will be on the right and Parchment Valley Road (big, blue sign) will be on the right and Parchment Valley Road and travel for 2 miles. The road will open to the Parchment Parchment Valley Conference Center complex.
